

Policy Governing a Request to Student Teach Outside of the University's Supervision

Whereas student teaching is considered the capstone course within a teacher education program and an essential performance assessment for completion of a professional education program, UCTE approves the policy that candidates requesting to student teach outside of the University's supervision will be made at the program level. Consideration will be given to requests based on extreme hardship or circumstances that would enhance the candidate's educational experience (e.g., student teaching abroad). Candidates who student teach outside of the University's supervision must complete all major student teaching assessments and the approved supervisory personnel must complete the Pathwise final assessment.
