## **Policy on Substituting and Employment of Teacher Candidates**

Occasionally it is permissible in the absence of his/her clinical educator for a short period of time, for the teacher candidate to assume responsibility for his/her clinical educator(s) on the condition that the school principal, the field instructor, the clinical educator(s) and the teacher candidate discuss and agree to the arrangement. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD A TEACHER CANDIDATE BE USED AS A SUBSTITUTE IN A CLASS OTHER THAN THAT TO WHICH S/HE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED. In all situations where teacher candidates are being used as substitutes, the district will assume liability.

Teacher candidates are teachers in training and must not be used as substitute teachers on a regular basis.

All students who wish to receive University credit for student teaching must register for the course and complete the experience under the supervision of a clinical educator in the classroom and a field instructor. Students who opt to accept positions as long-term substitutes cannot receive University credit for this experience.
